The book is designed with a very simple and friendly user interface in mind, and is packed with a lot of unique features:

- * Automatic bookmark: by reopening the application you will be automatically repositioned where you left the reading
- * Easy reading with a choice of font sizes (landscape reading is possible)
- * Choice of background color
- * A powerful search engine for words
- * Index of characters and places
- * Conceptual map of the Dante's world
- * Numbering of verses
- * Easy annotations of verse
- * Preloaded with 2100 annotations by H.W. Longfellow
- * 130 illustrations by Gustave Dore
- * "Quote of the Day": a random verse from the poem

This application doesn't requires an internet connection. It is especially designed for those who, either for study or pleasure, needs to have on hand the masterpiece of Dante Alighieri. The Divine Comedy, written by Dante Alighieri between 1308 and 1321, is widely considered the most important poem of Italian literature, and is without any doubt one of the greatest works of world literature.
