Compose a new entry using the portrait keyboard or the wider landscape one. While editing, extraneous text and icons are hidden so you can focus on your words. Weave memories into your entries by adding photos from your library. You can delete the photos from your library but Chronicle will maintain a copy. Perfect for things you want to keep private, or for capturing special moments.

Unlike other diary and journal apps, you can add more than one photo. Make it personal: Chronicle allows you to change the background color to something you like. You can also adjust the font size and style. Need a secret, locked diary? Enable the privacy feature, set a passcode, and only you will be able to access the app. Each entry can be annotated with a small, iconic badge to signify the theme of the entry.

Worried about losing your work? Use Chronicle's backup feature to export your diary to Google Docs. Google's service is secure and only you will be able to log in and view your journal. You can also save the online copy of your journal as a PDF or Word doc. If you've been looking for an online diary or personal diary software, this could be the answer. Not a free journal, but close and it comes with many other benefits.
