Saturday's programming features a round table discussion of the issues and solutions for application development targeted at multiple platforms. Sunday's events will exhibit entries from the Hackathon contest in which demonstrations from the previous day's work will be exhibited in 3-minute presentations. Following the competition an awards ceremony will take place including Special Awards, which will reward values of sharing, participation, and "can do" attitude.
