Together, AssistiveWare and Easter Seals DuPage and the Fox Valley Region worked for several months on the Proloquo2Go App Donation Program to make sure it would have all the right checks and balances in place. To be eligible for the donation program an Augmentative Communication Evaluation by a licensed Speech Language Pathologist must be included with the submission of each application. An application will first be reviewed by the financial office of the Easter Seals DuPage and the Fox Valley Region center for compliance with the financial need requirements of the donation program. If the application meets these requirements, it will be reviewed by an AAC reviewing from team of the Center. Among other things, an AAC specialist will then evaluate whether or not Proloquo2Go meets the needs of the client.

"Easter Seals is very excited to partner with AssistiveWare to help distribute Proloquo2Go to individuals who need this support for communication," shares Kathleen Post, Assistive Technology Department Manager at Easter Seals DuPage and the Fox Valley Region. "This partnership provides a way that individuals with significant financial and communication need are able to obtain and utilize this powerful app."

With this donation program AssistiveWare and Easter Seals DuPage and the Fox Valley Region hope to help many individuals and families. AssistiveWare believes Proloquo2Go can make a difference to many individuals with speech impairments, but as it may not always be the most appropriate solution it is important to partner with organizations such as Easter Seals DuPage and the Fox Valley Region.
