- * Improved Login Handling on Dynamic Websites - In the last release of 1Password, some web sites that were dynamically generated would not allow saving of Logins. 1Password would incorrectly report 'No Logins Found' when saving. A similar issue would happen when restoring a Login. This release fixes this issue.
- * Full Change Log - The full detailed changelog for this release can be found on the 1Password web site.

System Requirements:

- * Mac OS X 10.4 (Tiger) or 10.5 (Leopard)

Pricing and Availability:

A Single User license is available for \$39.95 (USD) and a five user Family License for \$59.95 (USD). 1Password may be downloaded for free from the Downloads page. A fully functional 30-day trial version is available, along with a free version limited to 20 items. Special media licenses are available for members of the press and the blogging community upon request.
