Compatible with USB or Bluetooth joysticks and gamepads, Joystick Mapper allows anyone to configure their joysticks or gamepads to simulate keyboard keys/mouse movement/mouse click/mouse scroll. Joystick Mapper offers ready-to-use examples and easily modifiable. Players may easily control any app or game using any of these controllers, even the controllers without built-in support.

- * You may need to install a third party driver for PS3 and Xbox controllers

- * One or more compatible Joysticks, Gamepads or Controllers
- * An available USB port for USB Joysticks
- * For Bluetooth Joysticks: Internal Bluetooth (all recent macs include this) and External Compatible USB Bluetooth dongle
