Minimum Requirements:

- \* Mac OS X version 10.5 or higher (Mac version)
- \* iPhone OS version 2.2 (iPhone version)

Pricing and Availability:

Yum for the iPhone is freely available from the App Store. Yum for Mac OS X is \$30 (USD), and available as a free download from the Yum website. It runs initially in a 15-day trial mode with all features active. This is a free upgrade for registered users.
