Horizon uses familiar Mac UI elements, such as drag-and-drop to move or copy values, context sensitive menus, animation, help in the form of an Apple Help book, and a toolbar for commonly used functions.

Horizon stands as an alternative to check-book register-based systems and spreadsheets for people who want a simple, free-form way to budget and plan their finances.

Horizon is available for immediate download as a 30-day trial version, and a single-user license costs only \$29.95 US.
