Corporate Smalltalk Consulting Ltd. today announces WikiServer 1.4.4, an update to their wiki management tool for iPhone and iPod Touch. Using WikiServer, it is possible to create a fully functional Wiki. Users can easily create, edit, and share a Wiki directly from their iPhone or iPod touch. Version 1.4.4 now supports the ability to export/import data from the device to desktop computers and serve pages using the desktop version of their Wiki software.
