Version 1.4 adds synchronization with the RSS service Feed Wrangler.

With OneReader:

- * You are in complete control of your news sources: your favorite web sites through RSS feeds and your contacts on social networks
- * OneReader turns your Twitter, Facebook, LinkedIn and App.net timelines into a stream of articles, presented with their title and an excerpt
- * Your friends' and contacts' posts become comments to the articles and you can reply, favorite or like directly from the app
- * You can keep track of what you have read: you receive each article only once, even if it is shared across multiple sources
- * You enjoy various options for sharing and storing articles (Twitter, Facebook, Evernote, Pocket, Instapaper, create task in Omnifocus or Things, etc.)
- * You can read your news on any of your devices (iPad, iPhone, iPod touch) with full synchronization

OneReader aims to make it easy to deal with information delivered as streams. Future versions will include additional sources, more sharing and storage service options as well as an even more streamlined interface. In future versions, additional features are planned to assist with managing very large streams.
