Tropical Software today announced TopXNotes 1.4.1, its award-winning personal information manager for Mac OS X. TopXNotes has been fully tested and is compatible with Mac OS X version 10.6, Snow Leopard. TopXNotes offers two levels of security: all notes can be password protected individually, and the entire database can be encrypted with a unique password. URIs for web sites can be clicked on to open their web page in the user's default browser.

Users of Snow Leopard will also benefit from a new feature in Preview, which makes it easy to copy text from multi-column documents for pasting into a TopXNotes note. Tropical Software is also working on a program for the iPhone and iPod Touch that will allow TopXNotes to be synchronized with those devices.

Sue Beal, president of the Upper Keys (Florida) Macintosh Users Group calls TopXNotes "Inexpensive, unobtrusive, and just plain handy."
