Dedicated controls are provided for seagull, frog, and cricket sounds. Lights slowly change colors in interesting and dynamic ways. Sunset colors create relaxing, slowly dimming nighttime routines.

Any of the water theme colors can be configured to use sunset colors. This combination of yellow, orange, and intermediate colors is conducive to a relaxed and peaceful ambience. Nature sounds appear in millions of different locations, near and far, as the app moves them through space and time using advanced soundscape algorithms.

The water effects are available as the "Water" In-App purchase. No other In-App purchase is needed to use the water effects. Once purchased all lights recognized by the Philips Hue bridge can be included in any water effect. To get the best effects ZigBee-compatible LED bulbs that support color should be used.

Other recent additions to the Hue Lights app include 3D Touch for pressure sensitive light control, Touchlink for finding lost bulbs, sequences, direct editing of scenes on the bridge, and customization of Hue dimmer switch and Hue Tap buttons. Each button on the Hue dimmer switch can be configured to control scenes, groups, and brightness. Select different scenes with a long-press or short-press of the button. Map up to 8 scenes on a single Hue dimmer switch. A comprehensive list of features and support material is available on the official Hue Lights website.

Hue Lights was first launched in December 2013 and has seen steady growth from a worldwide user base. The app includes Apple Watch support, scene and group activation from a fast widget, native Philips hub scheduling, dynamic lighting and a large selection of custom scenes.
