- * Convert image formats
- * Optimize files for web and mobile devices
- * Run a Photoshop Action on each image

As a result, users can save gigabytes of disk space and hours of optimizing images manually, accelerate document output, reduce job turnaround and cut costs through faster processing.

LinkOptimizer can be purchased from Zevrix website for \$259.95 USD (Light version: \$179.95) as well as from authorized resellers. Trial is also available for download. The update is free for LinkOptimizer 5.x users and \$130 to upgrade from previous versions. LinkOptimizer requires Mac OS X 10.6-10.12 and Adobe InDesign/Photoshop CS5-CC 2015.
