- \* Route files by preflight results into success and error folders
- \* Export PDF as images with given resolution and color
- \* Split PDF files into single pages

PDF Checkpoint can be purchased on Mac App Store and Zevrix website for \$39.95 (USD), as well as from authorized resellers. The update is free to licensed users. Trial is also available for download. PDF Checkpoint requires macOS 10.7-10.12.
