The new version lets users preview Adobe InDesign documents thus eliminating the need to open them for identification or even have InDesign installed on the user's machine.

The new version add the ability to show previews of Adobe InDesign files, which functionality isn't available through the Mac operating system. Now users can quickly identify InDesign documents by their contents directly from Graphic Inspector without the need to open the files manually. In fact, users don't even need to have InDesign installed on their system. All versions from InDesign CS5 and later are supported.

- * Check files for spot colors, fonts, image compression and more
- * Search by resolution, color mode, ICC profile and bit depth
- * Complete EXIF, IPTC and GPS metadata

Graphic Inspector can be purchased from the Zevrix web site for \$19.95 (USD), as well as from authorized resellers. Graphic Inspector is free with purchase of PDF Checkpoint or InPreflight Pro for Adobe InDesign. Trial is also available for download. The update is free for users of version 2.x and \$10 for earlier versions. Graphic Inspector requires macOS 10.5-10.12 (some features require OS X 10.7 or later).
