Power Manager 3.7 introduces time zone support. When a Mac's time zone changes, Power Manager immediately updates the schedule to ensure scheduled events occur as expected. Time zone support ensures Power Manager is both a good travelling companion and suitable for global deployments. This improvement particularly helps Power Manager users who frequently travel with their laptops.

Power Manager 3.7 includes other improvements and bug fixes detailed in the release notes, including improved documentation, status menu, and Quick Schedule.

Power Manager helps schools and businesses save energy by automating Mac computers. Users can schedule their Macs to start up or wake, shut down, restart, log out, switch to the login window, wake, and sleep.

Power Manager scales from one Mac to ten thousand with ease and is suitable for managed environments. Power Manager 3.7 includes an administrator guide and bug fixes that ease network deployment.
